

SERMON Noah and the Flood: New Life and Covenant Mr Tan Chong Jin

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: Noah and the Flood: New Life and Covenant

Scripture Passage: Genesis 6:9-17 & 9:1-11

BIG IDEA: God brings renewal out of judgement.

Key Verses: Genesis 9:11 (NIV)

"I establish my covenant with you: Never again will all life be destroyed by the waters of a flood; never again will there be a flood to destroy the earth."

Introduction

- From the fall of humanity in Genesis 3, sin and violence became increasingly widespread (Gen 6:5, 11-12)
- God was grieved by humanity's ever-increasing rebellion and wickedness (Gen 6:6)
- Sin and violence threatened to overtake God's creation
- God acts in judgment to:
 - Overthrow evil
 - Preserve the righteous
 - Allow space for righteousness to flourish through renewal

Key takeaways from Noah's story:

1. Judgement is real

God will act to overthrow evil

- God will not allow evil to persist
- Evil always threatens God's good intentions for creation
- God's judgment is necessary if God's righteousness and good purposes are to be established

2. Righteousness makes a difference

God looks for the righteous in every generation

- One man's righteousness in his generation preserved a few people and animals to survive God's judgment (Gen 6:9,18-20)
- Christ's righteous life ultimately makes God's justification and life accessible to all people (Rom 5:15-19)

3. God's New Creation God renews creation to allow righteousness to flourish

- God's Covenant with Noah allowed life to continue while recognizing the inherent wickedness of humanity (Gen 8:20-21)
- God's New Covenant through Christ brings new life and restores righteousness to humanity (2 Cor 5:17-21, Rom 8:28-30)

Conclusion

Know: God's judgement and renewal work together to bring about new life and righteousness in creation

Be: Righteous by believing in God's Son, Jesus Christ

Do: With God's help and power, live righteously for this generation

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. Discuss why God's judgement can be a challenging reality to accept within the church and outside the church.
- 2. Was God's judgment in Noah's time more for the punishment of the wicked or making space for the righteous to survive, *or both?*
- 3. How does the story of Noah give us hope that God brings new life and restoration out of judgement? How does this new life in Noah's time (Genesis 8:20 9:17) compare with God's new creation in Christ (2 Cor 5:17-21)?
