SERMON OUTLINE

Title: By The Blood of the Lamb **S**cripture Passage: Exodus 12:1-14

Observation

1. The purpose of Passover?

Setting themselves apart as **Holy**.

The sacrifice **atoned** for the sin of the people

The blood smeared on the doorframes **purified** those within.

Eating of the sacrifice **consecrated** those who consumed it

By participation in the Passover the people sanctified themselves as **a nation holy to God**.

2. The Destroyer Claims All!

They did not listen to Moses - God's Prophet (Exo 5:21)

They brought their idols with them (Josh 24:14)

There is no one that is good, only God is good. (Mark 10:18)

All Have sinned and fall short of the Glory of God (Rom 3:23, 6:23)

"death came to all men, because all sinned" (Rom. 5:12)

3. The Blood of the Lamb of God.

Not destruction but salvation.

By **believing** through faith an **atonement** was provided.

Atonement = A lamb offered as an **offering** for sin.

A ram for Isaac (Gen 22:8), A lamb for each household (Exodus),

A **scapegoat** for the nation on the Day of Atonement (Leviticus).

The **Lamb** of God for the world (Gospels).

Jesus said "I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you."

John 13:15-17

Application

Know: You are saved from destruction by the blood of the Lamb of God.

Be: Humble and Holy as you partake of Holy Communion **Do**: Prepare your hearts to serve sacrificially as Jesus did.

Prayer

Lord, as we partake of the body and blood of the Lamb of God, help us to come with humility and thanksgiving for Your grace so freely given. Help us to follow the example of our Lord Jesus Christ who showed the full extent of His love for us and washed us clean. We ask in the name of Jesus Christ, Amen.

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION

- 1. Do you think too highly of yourself rather than with sober judgement?
- 2. Do you come to Holy Communion with thanksgiving?
- 3. Are you serving according to the example of Jesus?

CONGREGATIONAL PRAYER

Father, on the night on which He was betrayed, Your Son Jesus Christ washed His disciples' feet and said that they ought to wash one another's feet. He shared a meal with them. Giving thanks for the bread, He broke it and gave it to His disciples to eat and remember His body given for them. Lord, hear us.

Lord, increase our faith.

On this night, Jesus told His disciples that He was going to prepare a place for them. We remember in Your presence all who have fallen asleep and those who have been bereaved...

Lord, hear us.

Lord, renew our hope and trust in You.
