

SERMON The Response of Faith: Abram and Lot, Melchizedek Mr Tan Chong Jin

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: The Response of Faith: Abram and Lot, Melchizedek

Scripture Passage: Genesis 13:5-15 & 14:17-24

BIG IDEA: Faith makes us see beyond immediate circumstances.

Key Verse: Genesis 13:15 (NIV)

All the land that you see I will give to you and your offspring forever.

Introduction

- God's promise of blessing to Abram was tested through various times in Abram's life
- Sometimes the promise seemed threatened by setbacks and circumstances
- But God works providentially to ensure His promise progresses to fulfilment
- God acts providentially to:
 - Remove obstacles
 - Create space
 - Test character

Abram's faith responded with:

1. Honour

Not grasping for what God has already promised

- Even though Abram was the elder, he generously allowed Lot to choose first in a land dispute between their herders (Gen 13:5-9)
- Lot chose what seemed to be the superior choice (Gen 13:10) but God providentially preserved Abram's inheritance of the land
- By not grasping for the obvious advantage, Abram discovered God's superior choice for him instead (Gen 13:14-17)

2. Humility

Submitting to Spiritual Authority

- Although Abram was in a position of strength after a military victory, he recognized Melchizedek's royal priestly authority (Gen 14:17-20)
- Abram gave a tenth of what he had after receiving a priestly blessing
- By submitting to spiritual authority, Abram understood that his successes could have only come from God alone

3. Hope

Seeing beyond the present circumstances/opportunities

- The king of Sodom's offer of having Abram keep the bounty of war presented an opportunity to profit from his recent military victory (Gen 14:21)
- Moreover, his success could have offered an opening to exert military dominance over the area
- However, Abram rejected these opportunities and placed his hope in the security and reward that only God can provide (for e.g. see Gen 15:1)

Conclusion

Know: God works to bring His promises to fulfilment

Be: Faithful to how God wants us to live

Do: Live in way that is *honourable* in God's sight, *humbly* submitting to His authority and putting your *hope*

in His faithfulness

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. In your present family and other relationships, what are areas that make it difficult to treat one another honourably?
- 2. Why does God place us under spiritual authority? In what ways do you find submitting to spiritual authority a challenge?
- 3. How can we know whether it is the right time to seize the opportunities before us or to wait in trust for God's leading?


