

SERMON

Our Covenant-Making God

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: Our Covenant-Making God Scripture Passage: Genesis 17:1-21

BIG IDEA: God calls us to a covenant relationship.

Key Verse: Genesis 17:1b (NIV)

"I am God Almighty; walk before me faithfully and be blameless.

Introduction

- Abram has now lived in Canaan for nearly 25 years
- By now his first-born son Ismael is 13 years of age and has become the focus of Abram's hopes to extend his family line
- But God clarifies that His covenant promises would be fulfilled through another son, one that would be born to Abram and Sarai
- God's covenant with Abram included:
 - Life of intimacy with God (Faith)
 - Life marked out for God (Circumcision)
 - Life of Promise (Isaac and the Future)

What we learn from God's Covenant with Abram:

1. Intimacy brings life

A living relationship with God is the basis of living

- Abram is to live faithfully in God's presence
- Being blameless before God is a result of intimacy with God
- Looking to God first enables us to live in relation with God purposes around us (e.g. John 5:16-17)

2. Identity forms destiny

God gives us identity and meaning in life

- God gave Abram and Sarai new names to mark out their destiny
- Abraham's family is to be marked out by circumcision as a sign of the covenant
- Our identity and destiny are now in and with God's Son, Jesus Christ (Galatians 2:20, 2 Corinthians 5:17)

3. Impossible becomes irrelevant

What is impossible to us is possible with God

- We are responsible to live rightly and wisely before God
- But what is beyond us is still under God's sovereign authority
- It was impossible for Abraham and Sarah to conceive a child at their age
- However, their age limitation was irrelevant *in relation to God's intention* to bring about the Covenant promises through Isaac

Conclusion

Know: God calls us to a life of faith and intimacy with Him

Be: Faithful to our identity and destiny with Christ

Do: Seek to live in a way that is consistent with God's covenant relationship with us in Christ

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. What does an intimate life with God mean to you?
- 2. What are the times you find it hard to remember or experience your identity and destiny with Christ?
- 3. For Abraham and Sarah, God was going to overcome the impossible. Reflect on the areas in your life right now that you need to believe that God will either overcome the impossible for you or enable you to *endure through* the impossible.
