SERMON The Legacy of Faith Mr Tan Chong Jin

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: The Legacy of Faith

Scripture Passage: Genesis 24:1-21

BIG IDEA: Build a legacy of faith for the next generation

Key Verse: Genesis 24:7 (NIV)

The Lord, the God of heaven, who brought me out of my father's household and my native land ... - he will send his angel before you so that you can get a wife for my son from there.

Introduction

- Abraham was full of years and had enjoyed God's blessings and abundance.
- His thoughts are now focused on ensuring Isaac is in a position to inherit all of God's covenant promises.
- One key aspect of this is ensuring Isaac finds a wife from within the cultural-identity group of Abraham's family.
- Because of God's providential grace, Abraham leaves a legacy of:
 - i. Faith: A life of belief in God.
 - ii. **Family**: A family that will bear the Covenant promises.
 - iii. **Future**: A destiny to be possessed by future generations.

What we learn from Abraham's legacy of faith:

1. Profound Belief

God inspires deep-rooted faith in those who choose to trust in Him

- Despite considerable wealth, Abraham was still living in tents as a foreigner in the land full of Canaanite tribes.
- But because of God's faithfulness in his life, Abraham was able to see God as the architect and builder of all that He has promised for him (Abraham) and his future descendants.
- Ultimately God's promises leads to a destiny of living in God's presence (city) (Hebrews 11:9-10).

2. Persistent Belonging

Finding hope and identity in the reality of God's Promises

- Intentionally living out God's Promises despite the pressing distractions of our external world.
- Abraham chose to believe the promise of the land was already a reality despite evidence to the contrary.
- Abraham made specific plans to find a wife for Isaac with a sense of belonging to land that God has promised.

3. Progressive Breakthroughs

God Himself acts to sustain and fulfil His promises

- God's breakthroughs in Abraham's life brought him ever closer to the fulfilment of God's promises (even though actual fulfilment would be generations more to come).
- God's breakthroughs often come out of extended periods of waiting and character formation.
- The providential encounter with Rebekah by Abraham's servant was a breakthrough that ensured God's covenant promises would continue with Isaac.

Conclusion

Know: God enables us to build a legacy of faith.

Be: Identified with how God has promised to shape our future with Christ

Do: Intentionally live by believing God will be faithful to His promises so that the next generation may also come to believe in Him.

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. What are some key promises of God in Scripture that call for profound belief on your part?
- 2. Reflect on times in your life where God acted in a way that impacted you or the circumstances around you.
- 3. What are areas that God is building faith and character in this season of your life that you can impart to the next generation?


