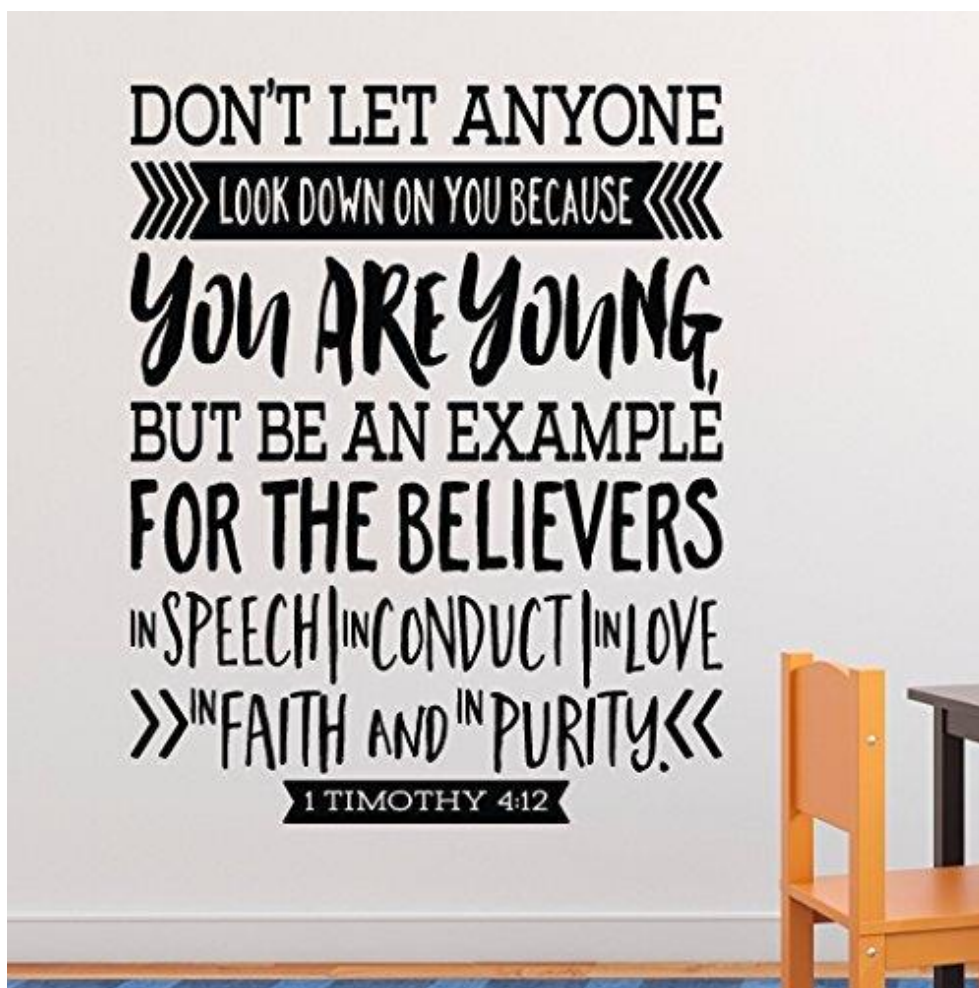

Title: Child of the Father

Scripture Passage: Genesis 26:1-11; 24-25

BIG IDEA: We are responsible for our own faith.

Introduction

2. Taking Ownership of Our Own Faith

- A God of generations.
- Isaac had to OWN the faith that Abraham left behind.
- Fear can drive us to sin.
- The solution is awareness of God's presence.

Conclusion

- **Know:** Our God is a personal God throughout the generations.
- **Be:** Responsible for your own faith.
- **Do:** Learn and set the right examples.

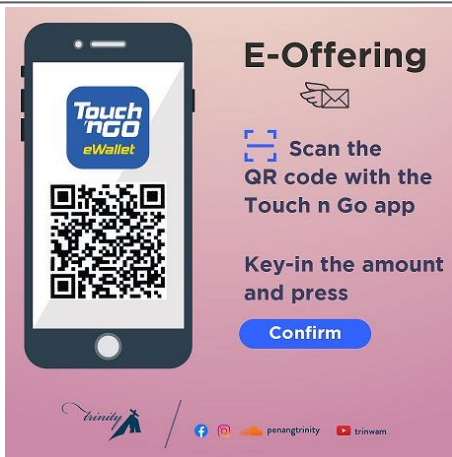
