SERMON We Covenanted Together to Be Disciples Rev Dr Andrew Tan

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: We Covenanted Together to Be Disciples Scripture Passage: Jeremiah 31:31-34; 1 Corinthians 11:17-34; Matthew 28:18-20

Introduction

By our covenant with God, we are covenanted with each other, and are therefore accountable to each other for our discipleship.

1. God Makes Covenant With Us to Be His Holy People

a. God made a covenant with Israel but they failed to keep it.

- He gave His Law that describes what His holy people would be like.
- He also gave them the tabernacle and filled it with His glorious presence.

b. God promised a new covenant to solve two problems.

- (See Jer. 31: 31-34; Eze. 26:27)
- The first is the problem of sin which separates us from God.
- The second is the problem of the heart which strays from God.

c. Jesus fulfilled the new covenant and solved the two problems.

- The Holy Communion reminds us that Jesus' shedding of His blood is how the new covenant was established (1 Cor. 11:25).
- Jesus's death and covenant with us solved the two problems: (1) the removal of sins which allows God to dwell among us, and (2) the change of heart through the HS which enables God's people to keep His laws.

2. God Requires Us to Be Faithful to His Covenant By Keeping His Law

- When God covenants with us, He requires us to be governed by His laws. ILL. 1 Cor. 11: 21-22.
- What are some "laws" that govern us Christians?
 - All God's moral laws in the OT especially the 10 Commandments.
 - Love one another. (Jn. 13:34; Gal. 6:2)
 - The teachings of Jesus in the Gospels especially the Sermon on the Mount.
 - The NT imperatives for the Christians. E.g. Live by the Spirit. (Gal. 5:16-26)

3. We Have Covenanted With Each Other to Keep God's Law

- Since we are bound to God by a common covenant, we are also bound to each other by that covenant.
- We have a moral obligation to grow as a holy people of God i.e. to become disciples of Jesus Christ. See Matt. 28:19-20.
- Baptism ushers us in to a life-long discipleship!
- How does a church organize a life-long discipleship?
 - Groups need to be small.
 - Groups have to be Word based.
 - Groups need to be accountable.
 - Groups need to have longevity.

Conclusion

I urge you to join a small group and that small groups practice accountability.

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. God's intention from the old covenant was that (a) we can come into God's presence to worship and (b) we keep His laws to be His holy people. How has the new covenant helped us to do this where the old covenant failed?
- 2. How do you explain that the new covenant governs our behaviour? See 1 Cor. 11:21-22ff. What Christian teachings should govern our behaviours? How conscientious have you been in obeying those teachings?
- 3. (a) How and why does our baptism usher us into a life-long discipleship? See Matt. 28:18-20. What does the idea of life-long discipleship mean to you? (b) Explain how our covenant with God relates to accountability with one another. How would you want accountability to be practiced in your small group?
