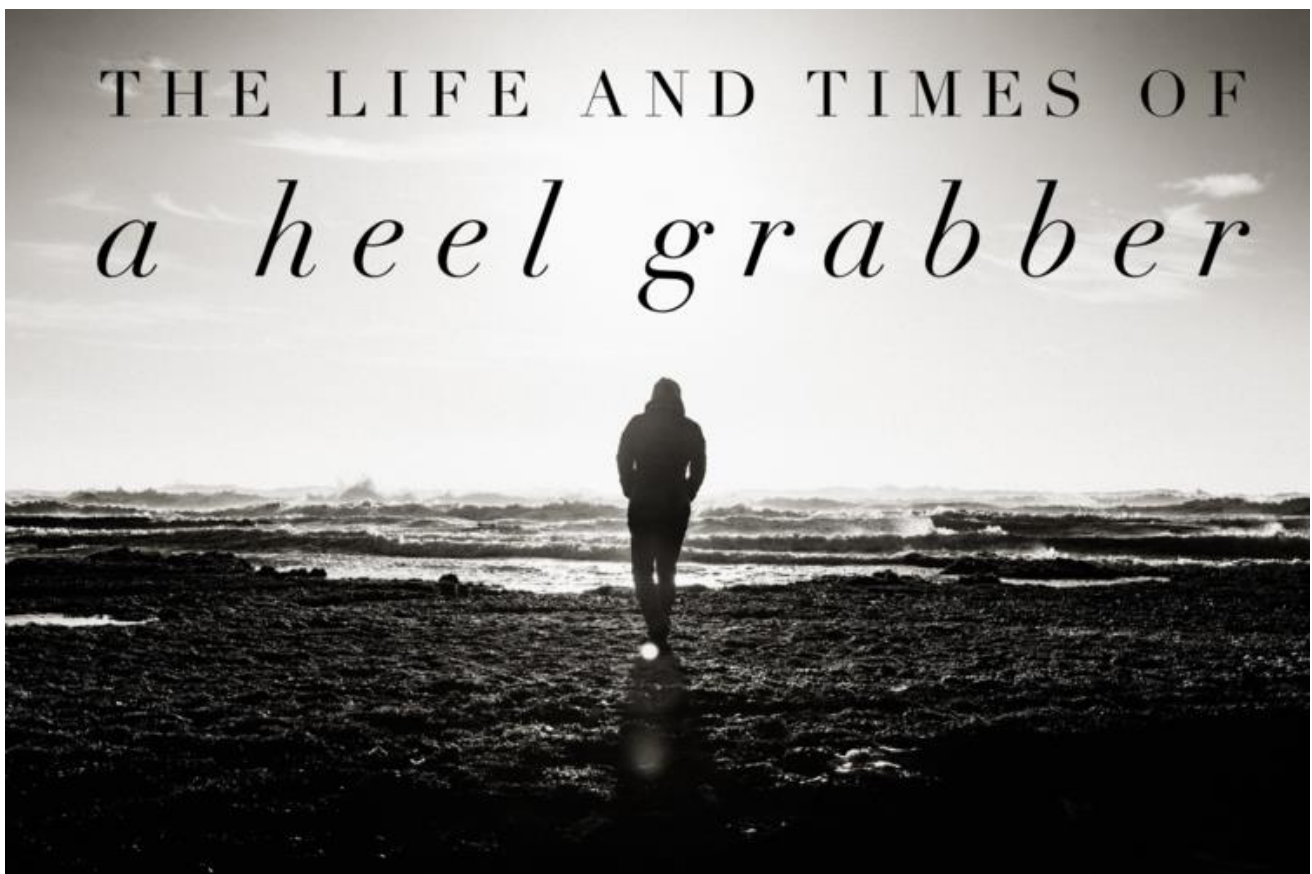

- There have been spikes in COVID-19 cases in countries where international sporting events have drawn thousands of spectators gathering in stadiums, with the majority not wearing masks or practicing social distancing. 
Communion Offering for July 2021 will go to the poor and needy in Malaysia affected by the Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown.
