<u>SERMON OUTLINE</u> Title: On Covenant Road – Discerning Doors & Facing Fears Scripture Passage: Genesis 31:1-7,13-55

Big Idea: To Follow God faithfully, we need to discern His guidance and be careful of our fears.

Introduction: God often guides us using circumstances like 'Open' or 'Closed' doors. However, it is not always His will for us to walk through open doors nor is it to turn away from closed doors. We need to discern His will. As for facing our fears, trust is born out of faith and we should strive to act in faith, not out of fear.

- 1) God guides Jacob's return using different 'doors' of circumstances.
 - a) Internal desires of the heart
 - b) External tensions and threats
 - c) Spiritual convictions of HIs Word
- 2) While we should face our fears and act in faith, God remains sovereign and His will come to pass despite our failures.
 - a) Jacob succumbs to his fears even after being assured by God.
 - b) Fear spreads, Rachel also acted in fear.
 - c) Laban instead, feared God's warning and acting accordingly.

When Faith falters, Fear is fueled, and Fraud (deceit) follows.

Conclusion

Know: God is faithful and if we trust Him, He can keep us on the right path despite our failings.

Be: Discerning of circumstances, seeking His will to walk by faith and not by sight.

Do: Face and overcome our fears by trusting fully in His provision.

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

- 1. Have you ever turned away from an "open door" or found/forced a way through a "closed door"? In hindsight, do you think the decision was the right one? Discuss.
- 2. When was the last time you were fearful of the circumstances facing you? Did you manage to fully trust God? Share/Discuss.
- 3. What lessons have you learnt in trying to follow Christ and what help or changes are needed in order to follow Him better?


