Live as Children of Light

SERMON OUTLINE Title: Live as Children of Light Scripture Passage: Ephesians 5: 8-14

BIG IDEA: As children of the light of Jesus, we must reflect that light to the world around us.

Introduction

- Light as a metaphor:
 - o Light reveals truth.
 - Light guides.
 - Light helps us to avoid danger.

1. We are children of light (v.8)

- Not born into light.
- The contrast between darkness and light.
- The comfort of familiarity.

Reflection/Discussion Questions: What is one step you can take to be more familiar with identifying as a child of light? *For Kids: What is one good habit you can keep as God's child?*

2. Jesus is the source of light (vv.13-14)

- The gift of light.
- Plugging into the source.

Reflection/Discussion Questions: How are you staying plugged into the source of light, Jesus?

For Kids: What helps you to stay close to Jesus?

3. Reflecting His light (vv.9-11)

- Our role as light-bearers.
- Not all will embrace the light.
- Polishing the surface.

Reflection/Discussion Questions: What is one area of darkness that needs the light of Jesus? What can you do to shine His light there? *For Kids: What makes you different from other kids who aren't Christian?*

Conclusion

- Know: Jesus has made us children of light.
- Be: Familiar with being different.
- Do: Shine the light of Jesus on the darkness around you.


