**SERMON** The Making of Saul as Leader Tan Chong Jin

#### **SERMON OUTLINE**

Title: The Making of Saul as Leader

Scripture Passage: 1 Samuel 9:15-17, 10:5-7 & 10:23-27

BIG IDEA: God prepares and builds a leader for times of growth and adversity.

## Key Verse: 1 Samuel 10:6 (NIV)

The Spirit of the Lord will come powerfully upon you, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person.

#### Introduction

- Israel had rejected God when they demanded for a king. (1 Sam 8:6-7)
- But God graciously prepared Saul to be their king despite a compromised, non-ideal situation. (1 Sam 9:16)
- Saul starts well in response to God's anointing. (although he will eventually fail as a leader)

God prepares a leader through:

## 1. Anointing

A spiritual leader must be anointed.

- Spiritual leadership requires the Spirit's anointing/empowerment. (1 Sam 10:6,10)
- Spiritual leaders must be transformed and changed to take on their role. (1 Sam 10:6,9)
- Spiritual leadership must not depend on non-spiritual means and methods. (1 Sam 10:27, 11:12-13, Mark 10:42-43)

## 2. Appointment

God appoints spiritual leaders to have public impact.

- God appoints a leader for impact to the nation/community. (1 Sam 9:16, 10:23-25)
- God prepares the heart of followers to support a leader. (1 Sam 10:26)
- However, opposition is to be expected. (1 Sam 10:27)

## 3. Adversity

A leader is often called to serve in times of adversity.

- Times of uncertainty and adversity requires decisive spiritual leadership. (1 Sam 11:1-11)
- Adversity is an opportunity for spiritual growth and development.

#### **Final Point:**

• Ultimately, Jesus is the only Perfect King.

#### Conclusion

**Know:** God prepares and builds us as spiritual leaders.

**Be:** Prepared to take on more leadership roles. **Do:** Serve sacrificially for the sake of others.


