

The Power of a God-Centred Life

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: The Power of a God-Centred Life

Scripture Passage: 1 Samuel 16:14-23, 17:40-47

BIG IDEA: God works powerfully through a person of faith.

Key Verse: 1 Samuel 17:47a (NIV)

All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the Lord saves; for the battle is the Lord's.

Introduction

- David was anointed to be the king to replace Saul because he was a man after God's heart. (1 Samuel 13:14)
- God's Spirit began to work powerfully in David's life. (1 Samuel 16:13)

David's life shows us the power of:

1. God-Directed Praise

Praise is an expression of life with God

- A life of praise is an encounter with God and anticipates God's further action in the life of the worshipper.
- Praise is practising life with God as individuals and as a community of faith.
- David's life of praise was in 'real-time', realistic and calls for a response.

2. God-Centred Perspective

Seeing with the eyes of faith

- Where others saw a fearsome giant, David saw a defeated enemy. (1 Sam 17:23-24; 34-37)
- God-centred perspective sees how God can work.
- God-centred perspective prophetically sees the beyond the present reality to God's vision for the future. (e.g. Eze 37:1-14)

3. God-Given Prevailing Victory

God wins in the end

- God often works through people of faith to bring deliverance.
- David fought Goliath according to how God had prepared him. (1 Sam 17:34-37)
- But it was the LORD who brought the victory because the battle was His. (1 Sam 17:45, 47)
- Jesus Christ achieved God's ultimate victory over evil through the cross and resurrection. (Colossians 2:13-15, 1 Cor 15: 20-21, 54-57)

Would you bring to God now one area of your life that troubles you or makes you afraid?


