

The End of the Beginning

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: The End of the Beginning Scripture Passage: 1 Samuel 31:1-13

INTRODUCTION

- 1. To Be Continued
- 2. 1 Samuel 31 is the End of 1 Samuel but not the End
- 3. Today's Message:
 - Defeat of Israel (1 Samuel 31:1)
 - Death of Saul and his 3 sons (1 Samuel 31:2-6)
 - Disgrace of Saul (1 Samuel 31:8-10)

1. DEFEAT OF ISRAEL (V1)

- Defeat of Israel at Mount Gilboa
- Constant battles between Israel and the Philistines
- Defeats of Christians

• THE TAKEAWAY

- \circ The defeat of Israel by the Philistines is not the end but the end of the beginning
- Jesus' death on the cross was seen as a defeat. It is not the end. It is the beginning of victory over Satan

2. DEATH AT MOUNT GILBOA (V2-5)

- Fear of Death
 - \circ Dietrich Bonhoeffer's unshakeable faith that death is not the end
 - Death of Saul, his three sons, his armour bearer
 - At Mount Gilboa, Saul's 3 sons were killed (V2)
 - Saul was badly wounded by arrows and committed suicide without the help of his armour bearer at his side
 - o Saul's armour bearer also committed suicide
- David's lament for Saul
- THE TAKEAWAY
 - \circ $\;$ Your life is worth living no matter how bad it gets
 - Surround yourself with the right people who will be your armour bearers to join the battle against the "enemies of our souls"

3. DISGRACE OF SAUL (V8-10)

- The wicked acts of the Philistines
- Parallel between Saul and Jesus
- The valiant men of Jabesh-Gilead (V11-13)
- THE TAKEAWAY
 - $\circ~$ God showed mercy to Saul by giving him the honour of a proper burial by the loyal men of Jabesh-Gilead
 - Jesus was also given the honour of a proper burial by loyal followers like Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus

CONCLUSION:

- **Know:** That the Christian life is a three-pronged battle **the world** (the enemy around us), the **flesh** (the enemy within us) and the **devil** (the enemy above us). Stand firm.
- **Be:** Careful of the "Philistines" in your life. Saul was hit unexpectedly by an arrow. Are you aware of the arrow coming your way?
- **Do:** Honour the King of Kings and be loyal to God.

REFLECTION / DISCUSSION

1. What are your "thorns"? What has been your attitude towards them? How do you think God wants you to see them? How can you trust and submit to him so that you can thrive with these thorns?

For Kids:

Who do you turn to when you are fearful, worried and anxious?

2. Who are the armour bearers around you? Proverbs 13:20 says, "that he who walks with wise men will be wise".

For Kids:

What company of friends are around you in your neighbourhood or at school? 1 Corinthians 15:33 says, "Do not be misled: Bad company corrupts good character.

3. Have you shown loyalty and given honour to Christ who took away your sin? Jesus came to erase shame and disgrace and make us His own new creation. May God gives us grace to erase disgrace.

For Kids:

How do you honour Jesus Christ in your home and in your school?
