

Title: God Is the Ruler Yet

Scripture Passage: Acts 12:1-24

INTRODUCTION

- Attempts to stop the proclamation of the gospel: Acts 4:1-3, Acts 5:17-33
- Two-pronged persecution: Political Persecution and Religious Persecution

1. DEATH OF JAMES

- Political Persecution:
 - James was beheaded by Herod Agrippa 1 (Acts 12:1-2)
 - o Peter was seized and imprisoned by Herod Agrippa 1 (Acts 12:3)
- Religious Persecution:
 - Persecution by the Sadducees
- When evil triumphs:
 - A trying time of persecution for the early Christians death of James and the imprisonment of Peter
 - Our time is evil winning the day in our nation and the world?

THE TAKEAWAY

- When evil prevails, be reminded that God rules and over rules. God is in control
- The Gospel of Jesus Christ is Unstoppable!

2. DELIVERANCE OF PETER

- Extra prison security for Peter (Acts 12:4)
 - o Peter and John had mysteriously escaped from custody before (Acts 5:17-20)
- Earnest prayer for Pete's Release (Act 12:5)
- Peter's miraculous escape (Acts 12:6-11)
 - Peter the sound sleeper (Acts 12:6)
 - o Peter delivered by an angel of the Lord (Acts 12:7-11)
 - The doubt of answered prayer (Acts 12:12-17)
- Prison guards were executed (Acts 12:18-19)

THE TAKEAWAY

- Since God is almighty and in control, He can easily deliver you and I from humanly impossible situations if it is His will
- o No prison can shut God out or keep His servants in if He wills to free them

3. DEATH OF HEROD AGRIPPA 1

• The Danger of pride and contempt for God and man (Act 12:20-23)

THE TAKEAWAY

- There is no power greater than God who ultimately reigns over every human leader, evil or good
- o The Gospel of Jesus Christ is unstoppable (Acts 12:24)

CONCLUSION:

- God is almighty and can easily remove the most powerful and proud human leaders when it is His time to do so.
- Let us never forget GOD IS STILL THE RULER YET.
