## **SERMON OUTLINE**

Title: Completing the Mission Scripture Passage: Acts 27:9-26

**BIG IDEA: Complete the Gospel Mission for Our Generation.** 

Key Verses: Acts 28:30-31 (NIV)

For two whole years Paul stayed there in his own rented house and welcomed all who came to see him. He proclaimed the kingdom of God and taught about the Lord Jesus Christ—with all boldness and without hindrance!

### Introduction

- Paul travels to Rome in the last recorded journey in the book of Acts to appear before Caesar
- A raging storm threatened to sink the ship
- But the Lord sent word to Paul that his life would be spared so that Paul would be able to testify before Caesar (Acts 27:24)

Completing God's mission involves:

### 1. Uncontrollable Circumstances

Situations can get out of control, but not out of God's hands.

- Paul's advice not to set sail went unheeded (Acts 27:9-12)
- As a prisoner Paul was not in direct control of his circumstances, neither was he immune to the forces of nature (Acts 27:15-18)
- But the Lord's will and calling for Paul still overruled circumstances (Acts 27:23-25)

## 2. Unchanging Calling

God favours whom He calls.

- From the start, the Lord's calling was for Paul to testify and witness before Gentiles, kings and the people of Israel (Acts 9:15)
- This calling has not changed with circumstances Paul was preserved to testify before the 'greatest' of Gentile kings of his time the emperor of Rome (Caesar)
- God is able to preserve the lives of His servants until they fulfil God's purpose and calling for them

## 3. Undiminished Courage

Finishing well requires courage.

- The conviction and reaffirmation of God's calling gave Paul courage (Acts 27:22-25)
- The presence of God's people refreshed Paul's courage (Acts 28:15)
- Paul had the courage to continue proclaiming the Kingdom of God with all boldness as he awaited his trial before Caesar (Acts 28:30-31)
