SERMON OUTLINE

Title: We have found the Messiah! Scripture Passage: Matthew 1:1-17

Introduction

- 400 years of silence or intertestamental period between Malachi in the OT and Matthew in NT
- Matthew makes the claim that Jesus is the Messiah and then proves it by tracing His family tree back through King David to Abraham.

1. The Family Tree of Jesus

- The Gospel of Matthew opens with the family tree of Jesus
- The WHAT, WHY, HOW of the genealogy of Jesus
- Jesus Born and Adopted (Isaiah 9:6)

THE TAKEAWAY

 The eternal plan of God to save us from sin by sending His Son as the Messiah covers many generations from the beginning of time.

REFLECTION #1

As you ponder over the incredible plan and incredible gift of God's Son, how can you leave a legacy for being faithful to Christ?

2. The Hall Of Shame

- The family of Jesus is made up of people who come from less-than-respectable backgrounds and have less-than-perfect records.
- God has kept His promise to Abraham and David in spite of the sinfulness of man.

THE TAKEAWAY

- God uses actual people, not perfect people for His purposes.
- Jesus bore our sin and the shame of the past for his ancestors and us on the cross.

REFLECTION #2

How will you avail yourself to God to use you for His purposes in spite of your past?

3. We Have Found the Messiah: Come and See

- The woman at the well (John 4:29)
- Andrew and John (John 1:35-39)
- Philip told Nathaniel (John 1:46)

THE TAKEAWAY

- Our challenge is to also encourage our loved ones and friends to **come and see** the Lord Jesus for themselves.
- As long as we come to Him, we will be able to see who He is.

REFLECTION #3

What do you believe about Jesus? Do you think he was who he claimed to be? What do you need to trust God for in your life? Who do you believe that He is?

CONCLUSION:

- Have you found the Messiah?
- The redemption Jesus the Messiah brings is not just for Israel but for all humanity. He died on the cross not only for the Jewish people but also for the Gentiles.
