

SERMON OUTLINE

Title: A Greater Righteousness

Scripture Passage: Matthew 5:17-48

Introduction

We are experts in self-rationalisation or self-justification.

Main Points

- I. God's moral law is still valid and applicable to us today. (vv.17-18)
 - · We're still under the "authority of the Law".
 - We should have a high view of God's Word, like Jesus.
- II. Our righteousness is determined by our conformity to the Law, even greater than that of the Pharisees (vv.19-20)
 - We are not to disregard God's law or rationalise certain commands so that it's easier to obey.
 - We are to return to true intent of God's law as taught by Jesus.
- III. Perfect righteousness is required to enter into the kingdom of heaven. (v.48)
 - Only in Christ will we have a greater righteousness than the Pharisees.

Challenge

We need a new heart-righteousness.
