

SERMON OUTLINE Title: Two Parables on Servanthood in Luke Scripture Passage: Luke 12:35-38: 17:7-10

Luke 12:34 "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Introduction

The word "Servant/Slave" (doulos) is used more than 30x in Luke. Four parables on servanthood (Luke 12:35-38; 12:42-48; 17:7-10; 19:11-27).

1. Luke 12:34-38

- a) What is the servant to do.
- b) What is the Master's attitude to the servant?

2. Luke 17:7 -10

- a) What is the servant to do?
- b) What is the servant's attitude to himself?

Know: That You are the Servant of the Most High God, by His mercy and grace.

- Be: Be like Jesus our Lord and Master, who humbled Himself and took on the form of servant/slave (Philippians 2:7), in order that He might show us His love and to save US.
- **Do**: Ask the Lord to show you what He has given you to do. And resolve to fulfil the tasks or ministry that He has assigned you, whether big or small, with joy and thanksgiving, by the grace and power of the Holy Spirit,

-- so that you may hear say "Well done, good and faithful servant"
