

<u>SERMON OUTLINE</u> Title: The Unexpected Growth of God's Kingdom Scripture Passage: Matthew 13:10-17, 31-34

BIG IDEA: God's Kingdom grows in unexpected ways

Key Verse: Matthew 13:31b (NIV)

The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his field.

Introduction

- Jesus taught the people in parables (Matthew 13:10-11, 13:34-35)
- Parables were like a dividing line between those who understood the secrets of the Kingdom and those who were hardened in unbelief (Matthew 13:11-17)
- Through parables, Jesus revealed the nature and experience of God's Kingdom to those who had seeing eyes and hearing ears to believe in faith (Matthew 13:16-17)

The experience and growth of God's Kingdom involve:

1. Planting small seeds

Small beginnings, unstoppable impact

- The parables of the mustard seed and yeast (Matthew 13:31-33) shows how small beginnings can grow into wide-ranging impact
- We should never underestimate how God's Kingdom can grow to penetrate and impact the lives of those around us.
- Take-away: Are we ready to plant seeds for the Kingdom?

2. Persevering through opposition

Every good work is tested

- The parable of the weeds (Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43) prepares disciples to expect the work of the enemy to oppose God's Kingdom
- Good seeds grow up side by side with the bad seeds sown by the enemy. But in the end, Jesus will bring a separation of the bad from the good
- Take-away: Focus on the work of the Kingdom, not on the work of the enemy

3. Passion for God's Kingdom

Giving up everything for the One thing

- The parables of the hidden treasure and the pearl (Matthew 13:44-46) show the immense worth of finding and coming into God's Kingdom
- Those who would truly find God's Kingdom must give up everything else nothing must hinder or prevent disciples from entering and living in God's Kingdom
- Take-away: Is there anything holding me back from fully embracing God's Kingdom?
