Title: Reform or Relapse

Scripture Passage: 2 Kings 23:1-25

Introduction

- About Josiah
- Sermon Key points:
 - Rediscovery
 - Repent
 - Restore

1. Rediscovery

- The Book of the Law was lost and rediscovered
- Martin Luther's Rediscovery of the Word of God and Reformation

The Takeaway Message:

- We need to rediscover the power of God's Word in our lives
- When you find the Word of God, you find Jesus

Reflect & Apply:

- Have you lost God's Words in your life?
- "Have I lost the Word of God in my home?"

2. Repent

- The Rediscovery of God's Word leads to Repentance
- Josiah tore his robe when he heard the Word of God as act of repentance

The Takeaway Message:

- The Bible must be applied to one's life and daily living
- Only when the Word is applied in the context of our personal life, does the Word of God come alive

Reflect & Apply:

Have you made a covenant to walk after the Lord and keep His commandments?

3. Restore

- Restoration can be defined as an act of returning something to its former condition
- Restoring can also make things better than their current state
- Josiah Restored the Observance of the Passover (2 Kings 23:23)

The Takeaway/Reflection:

Restoration comes from Repentance

Reflect & Apply:

Are you guilty of worshipping God in ways that displease Him?

Conclusion:

Know when you find the Word of God, you find Jesus

Be true and genuine repentant in order to release the full restoration of God.


